Moments in History

Here's a collection of different moments in history, some of which you may have heard of and some other more unusual ones...

Diogenes was an ancient Greek philosopher who believed people should live as simply as possible. He lived in a barrel in the middle of a market of Athens and, when asked by Alexander the Great if he wanted anything, Diogenes said, "Yes. Get out of my sunlight."

The **NHS** was introduced in 1948; it was a hugely ambitious plan to bring good healthcare to all. For the first time, hospitals, doctors, nurses, pharmacists, opticians and dentists were brought together under one umbrella organisation to provide services that are **free for all** at the point of delivery.



Said the wrong thing? At least no one will remember it thousands of years from now - unlike poor **Hegelochus**, an Ancient Greek actor, whose mispronunciation of one word means he's still remembered today. While **performing** the play Orestes he was supposed to say, "after the storm I see again a **calm sea**," but instead he said, "after

the storm I see again a **weasel**". His mistake was ridiculed in so many other plays that his name has survived through history!

Hippocrates, a Greek physician now known as the The Father of Western Medicine, would diagnose his patients by tasting their pus, earwax and urine. The Roman Emperor **Caligula** once tried to invade Britain, then changed his mind, declared **war** on the sea instead and made his soldiers collect **seashells** from the beach as trophies of war.





Abolition of Slavery

"Am I not a man and a brother?"

Slavery on English soil was unsupported in English law and that position was confirmed in Somersett's Case in 1772, but it remained legal in most of the British Empire until the Slavery Abolition Act in 1833.

Women's Rights "I would rather be a rebel than a slave"

Before 1870, married women had to surrender all property and earnings to their husbands, effectively giving them the same legal status as an insane person or a criminal. Women were excluded from being elected and were even prevented from accessing higher education until 1878. The Representation of the People act was given Royal Assent from George V in 1918, giving approximately 8.4 million women the vote. The act, championed by suffrage pioneer Millicent Fawcett and suffragette leaders the Pankhursts, is considered a pivotal moment for women's rights and helped lay the foundations for progress towards greater political, social and economic equality.

Gay Rights "Marriage is about love, not gender"

LGBT rights equality has been on the rise since 1950, though there were laws in place against homosexuality in the UK until 1967. In 1992, the first pride festival was held in Brighton, a festival still popular today. However, change is accelerating: in 2013 England and Wales passed the marriage (same sex couples) act, with Scotland following in 2014. Then in 2015 Ireland voted by a huge majority to legalise same sex marriage, becoming the first country in the world to do so by a referendum. In 2017, the UK Supreme Court ruled discrimination against same-sex couples on pensions rights needs to end immediately.

Animal Rights "They feel equally"

Animal rights as a grassroots movement has been gaining momentum in recent years, with the message all animals have a right to liberty and life. A principal UK activism organisation, Surge, shares a vision of a world in which non-human animals are free from oppression and violence. Evidence of this movement gaining momentum is the announcement fashion designers will not use fur at London fashion week, citing a reflection of "cultural change" in consumer sentiment, with Helsinki also banning leather. We're also seeing a historical change in accommodation of the plant based diet by mainstream supermarkets and restaurants, further supporting the spread of this ethical movement, set to be the next biggest social justice change in history.

Carrots make you see in the dark



It's true that carrots are full of vitamin A, which is good for eye health, but that doesn't mean they give you night vision! The rumour was started by the British Ministry of Information during WWII to hide the fact that they had invented radar. Their new technology meant they could spot German planes coming over the channel sooner, but to keep the secret they started an advertising campaign encouraging the public to eat lots of carrots so they could see during blackouts!

Nero fiddled while Rome burned

In 64 AD, when the Great Fire of Rome broke out, Emperor Nero was 30 miles away in the city of Antium. When news reached him he rushed back to Rome to help: he paid for the relief effort, personally helped the search and rescue for victims, opened parks and palaces to provide shelter and arranged for food supplies to be delivered to survivors.



Fiddles wouldn't be invented for another thousand years, but Nero was proficient at playing the cithara (a type of string instrument, like a cross between a guitar and a harp).



Christopher Columbus sailed across the Atlantic ocean four times, but he never once set foot on mainland America. His voyages explored coastlines of Central and South America, and he spent a lot of time around Caribbean islands - but Columbus remained convinced that what he'd actually found was a new route to South Asia!

He wasn't even the first European to reach the American continent: Leif Erikson, an explorer from Iceland, got there 500 years before Columbus sailed by.



Despite them being associated with Nordic raiders in popular culture, the Vikings didn't wear horned helmets into battle. The 9th century Oseburg tapestry shows someone in a horned helmet, but either it's someone performing a ritual or it's supposed to be a god.

This myth comes from the 19th century revival of all things Norse, when horned Viking warriors were put into epic paintings and productions of Wagner. In fact the whole thing may be the fault of Prof. Cale Emil Doepler, Wagner's costume designer.


